North Carolina to Remain Paused in Phase 2

North Carolina will remain paused in "Safer At Home" Phase 2 for another five weeks as students and staff return to schools, colleges and universities, Gov. Roy Cooper announced Wednesday. N.C. DHHS Secretary Dr. Mandy Cohen said while some of the state's numbers have mostly leveled, any progress is fragile, noting other states have shown sudden surges in viral spread.
