

# Action Needed: Updating Your Agency's Security Contact

#### Provider Communication Bulletin Issue 61

- August 2021 Vaya will transition from the AlphaMCS Managed Care Information System (MCIS) platform to Conduent's Health Solutions Plus (HSP) platform.
- All providers must review the current security contact person in the Provider Maintenance Module of the AlphaMCS portal.
- If this role has changed within your organization, please submit an update using the Provider Change Request Form (you will need to complete Section E) posted on Vaya's Provider Central website.

Providers who do not provide security contact/Systems Access
Administrator contact information may be delayed in receiving
access to the Conduent platform until a Systems Access
Administration is assigned.

## Delayed: Specialized Foster Care Plan

 Specialty Medicaid managed care plan to meet the needs of children and youth currently and formerly involved in the child welfare system.

- July 1, 2022 July 1, 2023
- The one-year delay will allow time for additional design of and input on the key features of the plan.

## **COVID-19 Vaccine Update**

#### Currently eligible groups -

- Health care workers
- Long-term care staff and residents
- People 65 and older
- Child care and school staff

#### **Group 3 - March 3**

Additional frontline workers

#### Group 4 - March 24

- Individuals who have a medical condition that puts them at higher risk \*\*
- Individuals who live in congregate or close group living settings
- Individuals experiencing homelessness
- Individuals living in a homeless shelter
- Individuals in correctional facilities

## **New Vaccine Priority for People with I/DD**

#### Now (Group 1):

Any individuals with I/DD receiving 30 days or more of home and community-based services (HCBS)

#### March 24, 2021 (Group 4):

Individuals with I/DD who do not yet qualify for the vaccine




